#### **Hearing Aids Technology in Sacred Heart Church**

With new technology, comes great improvements. When Sacred Heart built our new church for Handicapped Accessibility, we did not overlook those who have difficulties with hearing. Inserted under the carpet around the pews, is a Hearing Loop System which is a thin wire that allows those with hearing aids to connect to our sound system. If you have the telecoil or t-coil function on your hearing aids (most do have it), just flip the switch on your hearing aids and the sound will broadcast direct to hearing aid.
