Father was going to check on possibility of having Mass in Meyer. Will need to do some insulation work before they start. Matt and Luke will look at attic to see if it is batt insulation.

Clean up day for around the faith formation center scheduled for May 4th at 10am.

Elections happening next month. Nominations this Sunday, Elections May 19th.
