She encouraged visitors and gave Annette the visitor's schedules which are Tuesdays and Thursday from 2 to 4. They do have a female prisoner right now that Margaret and Annette may go to visit this week or next. Bible Studies would have to be initiated by an ordained pastor.

We closed the meeting with a prayer for the Imprisoned.
